Description

Duration

Contracts range from a single class to a 12-month commitment

Responsibilities

- Teach art lessons for Pre-K through 12th grade students centered on BAM's collection and changing exhibitions.
- Engage students in thoughtful and meaningful discussions and facilitate art making in conjunction with established themes.
- Communicate and coordinate with other instructors, volunteers, and BAM Education Department staff.
- Abide by BAM's policies and procedures.
- Incorporate feedback from BAM staff and participants of the program.

Qualifications

- BA and/or pursuing degree in art, art education, or related field required.
- An interest in museums and art.
- Ability to teach technical art classes—drawing, painting, sculpture, etc.
- Experience teaching and curriculum development.
- Ability to adapt to a variety of classroom situations and utilize a variety of classroom management strategies.
- Ability to work well with students of all ages and abilities.
