### Description

- Engage students in thoughtful and meaningful discussions and facilitate art making in conjunction with BAM's outreach programs.
- Communicate and coordinate with teachers about scheduled classroom visits.
- Incorporate feedback as a result of instructor evaluations.

- BA and/or pursuing degree in art, art education, or related field required.
- An interest in museums and art.
- Experience teaching and curriculum development.
- Experience with technology—PowerPoint, laptops, projectors, etc.
- Ability to adapt to a variety of classroom situations.
- Ability to work well with teachers and students of all ages and abilities.
