Dear Artist,

Please read this letter carefully, as it contains important information regarding parking permits and access passes for the event.

ACCESS PASSES

Public access to Julia Davis Park will be restricted beginning Thursday morning, September 9, 2021 through Sunday night, September 12, 2021. **Artists and vendors who are loading and unloading into the park must display the official *Art in the Park* Access Pass on their vehicle dashboard to gain entry to areas of the park.** This pass will grant access to only the paved areas of the park. Driving on unpaved areas of the park is strictly prohibited at all times.

This Access Pass, which is valid for Thursday, September 9, 2021 ONLY, can be downloaded via the link included in the *Art in the Park* parking information e-mail sent to artists on August 5th. You will need this Access Pass to gain entry to the park during the set-up process, which begins on Thursday, September 9, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 7:00 p.m. **Please print, complete, and display this pass on your dashboard.**

Access Passes valid for the remainder of the weekend, Friday, September 10, 2021 – Sunday, September 12, 2021 will be enclosed in your registration packet, which you will pick up during Artist Check-In on Thursday, September 9, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please display this Access Pass on your dashboard for the remainder of the weekend.

OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS

Please note that the Access Pass is different from the permits required to park a vehicle overnight or lodge in a vehicle in the park. Please read the below information regarding overnight parking permits carefully.

UNATTENDED OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS

If you plan to park a vehicle or trailer in Julia Davis Park overnight, you are required to submit an **Unattended Overnight Parking Permit Application, for each vehicle, by Friday, August 13, 2021**. You must apply for this permit in advance. It will be included in your registration packet at check-in. There is **no fee** for this permit, and parking availability will be on a first-come, first-served basis. This permit does not guarantee a parking space. Information on how to submit this form is listed on the application form.

OVERNIGHT LODGING PARKING PERMITS

If you plan to sleep in your vehicle/RV/camper in Julia Davis Park, there is a separate permit process requiring you to submit an **Overnight Lodging Parking Permit Application and payment for each vehicle by Friday, August 13, 2021**. You must apply and pay for this permit in advance. It will be included in your registration packet at check-in. The cost for this permit is **\$30 per night (non-refundable)**. Information on how to submit this form and payment is listed on the application form. Please note that all vehicles permitted for Overnight Lodging must park in the Boise Pavilion Parking Lot (indicated in orange on the parking map) in Julia Davis Park.
